Question 2



The Tragedy of Hamlet, Prince of Denmark, often shortened to Hamlet. Set in Denmark, the play dramatizes the revenge Prince Hamlet are called to wreak upon his uncle, Claudius, by the ghost of Hamlet's father, King Hamlet. Claudius had murdered his own brother and seized the throne, also marrying his deceased brother's widow.

In the first act the protagonist of Hamlet is Prince Hamlet of Denmark, son of the recently deceased King Hamlet, and nephew of King Claudius, his father's brother, and successor. Claudius hastily married King Hamlet's widow, Gertrude, Hamlet's mother, and took the throne for himself. Denmark has a long-standing feud with neighbouring Norway, in which King Hamlet slew King

Fortinbras of Norway in a battle some years ago. Although Denmark defeated Norway, and the Norwegian throne fell to King Fortinbras's infirm brother, Denmark fears that an invasion led by the dead Norwegian king's son, Prince Fortinbras, is imminent.

The scene summary of Act 1 is verbatim below:

"O all you host of heaven! O earth! what else?

And shall I couple hell? O, fie! Hold, hold, my heart;

*And you, my sinews, grow not instant old, But bear me stiffly up. Remember thee!
Ay, thou poor ghost, while memory holds a seat
