Once you have successfully logged in to the myUNISA site, you will be presented with the Home screen, which we refer to as your Dashboard. The Dashboard displays essential information. It has four main sections:

- 1. Top Navigation
- 2. Lefthand Navigation
- 3. Middle Navigation
- 4. Righthand Navigation

## 1. Top Navigation:





#### Note: We move from left to right when viewing the above screen.

- **myModules (Dropdown menu):** This drop-down menu will provide you with a list of all the courses/modules you are enrolled in. (By clicking on a module, you will be directed to the course page of the selected module.
- **myAdmin:** By clicking on this tile, you will be directed to your personal space within the myUNISA site. Here is where you would store content for your courses.
